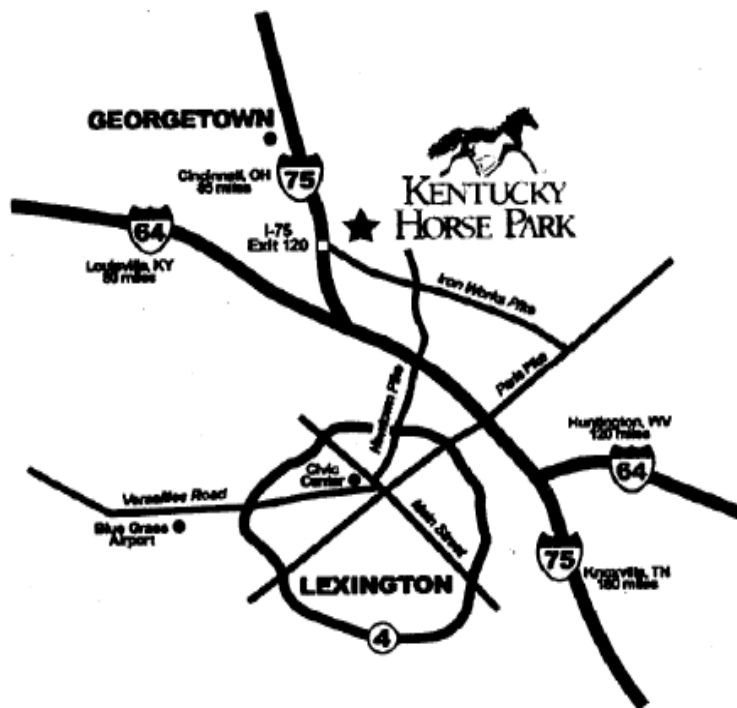

DIRECTIONS TO THE KENTUCKY HORSE PARK



The Kentucky Horse Park is located 4 miles north of Lexington, and 3 miles south of Georgetown, at I-75, exit 120.

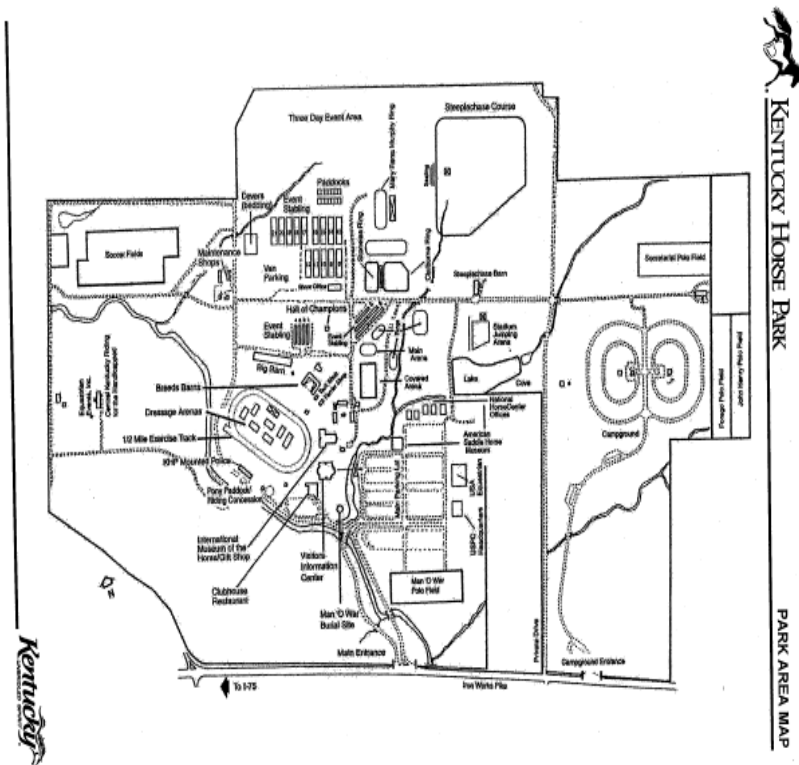
From Downtown Lexington: Travel north on Newtown Pike (992) to Iron Works Pike (approximately 9 miles) and turn left. Traveling west in approximately 2 miles The Kentucky Horse Park entrance will be on the right-hand side of the road.

From Louisville, Kentucky: Travel east on I-64 to I-75 north (approximately 70 miles). Take exit 120 from I-75 north and at the top of the ramp turn right onto Iron Works Pike in about .5 miles the Kentucky Horse Park entrance will be on the left-hand side of the road.

From Cincinnati, Ohio: Travel south on Interstate I-75 (approximately 70 miles) and take exit 120. Turn left at the top of the ramp onto Iron Works Pike in about .5 miles the Kentucky Horse Park entrance will be on the left-hand side of the road.

From Knoxville, Tennessee: Travel north on I-75 (approximately 173 miles) and take exit 120. Turn right at the top of the ramp turn right onto Iron Works Pike in about .5 miles the Kentucky Horse Park entrance will be on the left-hand side of the road.

From Charleston, West Virginia: Travel west on I-64 (approximately 168 miles) to I-75 north and take exit 120. Turn right at the top of the ramp turn right onto Iron Works Pike in about .5 miles the Kentucky Horse Park entrance will be on the left-hand side of the road.

WEEKLY PARKING PASS

\$18 fee will be assessed for the parking pass for the event. Weekly Parking passes for Trainers and Exhibitors may be obtained at the Parking Booth or Visitor Information Center upon entry to the park.

HORSE TRAILER PARKING

Horse trailer day fees are required for all competitors showing out of their trailer and must be purchased for **\$32 per entry at the Show office**. All trailers must park in approved lot. **NO PARKING** is allowed in the Barn area.

EVERY ENTRY AT A SHOW AFFILIATED WITH ESC AND RUN UNDER ESC RULES SHALL CONSTITUTE AN AGREEMENT AND AFFIRMATION THAT THE PERSON MAKING IT, ALONG WITH THE OWNER, LESSEE, TRAINER, MANAGER, AGENT, COACH, DRIVER, RIDER AND THE HORSE: (1) SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE SHOW RULES; (2) THAT EVERY HORSE, RIDER, AND/OR DRIVER IS ELIGIBLE AS ENTERED INCLUDING ATTESTATION AS TO AMATEUR/PROFESSIONAL STATUS); (3) THAT THE OWNER AND ANY OF HIS REPRESENTATIVES ARE BOUND BY THE SHOW RULES AND WILL ACCEPT AS FINAL THE DECISION OF SHOW MANAGEMENT ON ANY QUESTION ARISING UNDER SAID RULES, AND AGREE TO HOLD THE SHOW, ESC, THEIR OFFICIALS, DIRECTORS, AND EMPLOYEES HARMLESS FOR ANY ACTION TAKEN; (4) THAT THE OWNER, RIDER/DRIVER AND ANY OF THEIR AGENTS OR REPRESENTATIVES AGREE TO HOLD THE SHOW, ESC, AND THEIR OFFICIALS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES AND AGENTS HARMLESS FOR ANY INJURY OR LOSS SUFFERED DURING OR IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE SHOW, WHETHER OR NOT SUCH INJURY OR LOSS RESULTED, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, FROM THE NEGLIGENT ACTS OR OMISSIONS OF SAID OFFICIALS, DIRECTLY, FROM THE NEGLIGENT ACTS OR OMISSIONS OF SAID OFFICIALS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES OR AGENTS OF THE SHOW OR ESC.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ALL OWNERS AND EXHIBITORS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE OR INJURY CAUSED OR CONTRIBUTED TO BY THEM, THEIR AGENTS OR THEIR ANIMALS TO BARN OR OTHER PROPERTIES AND TO PERSONS ON THE SHOW GROUNDS AND WILL BE BILLED ACCORDINGLY. IN NO INCIDENT WILL THE KENTUCKY HORSE PARK OR THE KENTUCKY SPRING PREMIER HORSE SHOW BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE IN ACCIDENTS OR DAMAGE TO PERSONS OR ANIMALS OR LIABLE FOR ANY INJURY SUSTAINED IN ANY WAY TO EXHIBITORS, SPECTATORS, EMPLOYEES OR ANY OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES. NOR WILL THE KENTUCKY HORSE PARK OR THE KENTUCKY SPRING PREMIER HORSE SHOW AND ITS MANAGEMENT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ARTICLES LOST OR STOLEN. IT WILL BE THE CONDITIONS OF ANY ENTRY AT THE KENTUCKY SPRING PREMIER TO HOLD BLAMELESS ANY PARTIES CONNECTED TO THE SHOW FOR ANY TYPE OF LOSS.

- **ENTRY DEADLINE:** All Entries close **March 22, 2024**. Entries postmarked after this date will be charged post entry fees regardless of qualification date. **POST ENTRIES ARE REGULAR FEE PLUS \$20 per class. ENTRIES CAN NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY CHECK INCLUDING STALL FEES. STALLS WILL NOT BE RESERVED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL.**
- **Entries may also be paid by credit card by calling 859-333-1406 or on the entry.**
- **There will be no open charge accounts** without an open check in the office.
- **Every exhibitor, owner, agent or trainer must sign the entry blank** and be accompanied by a check covering all fees and charges.
- **All Entries** are required to have a Certificate of Equine Infectious Anemia Test (Coggins Test) within the past twelve months as required by the Kentucky State Veterinarian. No exceptions. ALL HORSES MUST HAVE A HEALTH CERTIFICATE issued by a veterinarian within the past 120 days with a temperature on each animal. **NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT CURRENT RESULTS**
- **THE KENTUCKY SPRING PREMIER HORSE SHOW WILL ADD A \$100 WINNERS PURSE TO FIVE RANDOMLY DRAWN CLASSES PER SESSION OFFERED IN THE 2024 SHOW. THE WINNING ENTRY IN THESE FIVE CLASSES RANDOMLY DRAWN BEFORE EACH SESSION WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO WIN AN ADDITIONAL \$100 BY HAVING BEEN ENTERED FORMS SUBMITTED BY THE ENTRY CLOSING DATE OF March 22, 2024. POST ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER THE ENTRY CLOSING DATE WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE WINNERS PURSE AWARDS.**
- **STALLS:** Horse and tack stalls are \$175 each for the entire show. Grounds Fee \$30 per Entry (Showing with no Stall). NO FIRST BEDDING PROVIDED. All stalls are 10 X 10 PVC panel permanent box stalls equipped with sliding doors and equimix asphalt flooring. Early ship in stalls available at \$60 per day. **Stalls will only be assigned to horses entered and competing in the Horse show.**
- **BARN AISLES:** Horses may be unloaded in the barn area but VANS MUST BE REMOVED FROM AREA IMMEDIATELY THEREAFTER. **VEHICLES MUST BE PARKED ONLY IN DESIGNATED AREAS. ANY VEHICLE PARKED IN THE BARN AREA, ON THE GRASS OR AREAS OTHERWISE DESIGNATED AS NON-PARKING AREAS WILL BE TICKETED AND TOWED** per rules from the Kentucky Horse Park.
- **COURTESY TO OFFICIALS:** Any act of discourtesy to the judges on the part of any exhibitor, owner, trainer or groom shall disqualify the horse and rider.
- **CONTROL OF HORSES:** Horses must be kept under control at all times. At the discretion of the judges and/or steward, horses may not be allowed to compete. Owner will forfeit entry fees.
- **UNITED PROFESSIONAL HORSEMAN'S ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP:** All exhibitors showing in Challenge Cup Classes must be Junior Members of UPHA. **Please join the UPHA prior to the show!**
- **TIME OUTS:** Only one (1) 5-minute time out may be requested per exhibitor per class. In case of casting a shoe or breakage of equipment in the paddock, the gate may be held no more than 3 minutes. There will be no delay after the first horse enters the ring, at which time the gate will be held for 2 minutes.
- **THE HORSE SHOW COMMITTEE** decision shall be final and shall decide all questions not covered in these rules and regulations.
- **PARKING:** All exhibitors will be required to pay a one-time fee of **\$6 upon arrival** and/or may purchase a parking pass for \$18 for the event. Please park only in designated areas.
- **PARKING (Grounds Fee) DAY PASS:** Horse trailer day passes are required for all competitors showing out of their trailer and must be purchased for \$30. All trailers must park in approved lot. **NO PARKING is allowed in the Barn area**

- **CANCELLATION/SCRATCHES:** Exhibitors canceling their entries after the official closing for any reason shall forfeit the accumulation of entry and stall fees. All scratching of horses at the show must be done at the show office one hour before the start of the session in which they are to compete. **PLEASE MAKE SCRATCHES EARLY AND BE CONSIDERATE TO OTHER EXHIBITORS.**
- **CHAMPIONSHIPS/STAKES:** Horses need not qualify to be eligible to show in CHAMPIONSHIPS/STAKES Classes.
- **RING DIMENSIONS:** Show Ring 135 feet x 309 feet –clay/river sand mix footing – Indoor Show Arena with Indoor Make up Area.
- **VETERINARIAN:** Dr. Ashley Craig-Hymer DVM, Lexington, Kentucky will serve as the official Horse Show Veterinarian Service and will inspect such horses designated by the judge(s) or steward to be considered unsound and will pass on any question pertaining to the soundness of any horse before being excused from the class. Her decision will be final.
- **BARN CALLS!** Entries must be prepared and report to the makeup area at least 10 minutes prior to the class in which they are entered. Kentucky Spring Premier will make every effort to announce the progress of the preceding class over speakers to the stable area. Barn calls are a courtesy of the show. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to present your horse prior to the gate closing.

Horses must be removed from the Kentucky Horse Park stalls by 8:00 AM Sunday, April 7, 2024. A stall map posted in the show office will show your stall location. **UNDER NO CONDITIONS ARE YOU TO STABLE HORSES IN ANY OTHER STALLS THAN THOSE DESIGNATED FOR YOU.**

KENTUCKY HORSE PARK

1. PARKING – Seasonal parking passes may be pre-purchased online or at the parking booth upon arrival for \$80. Weekly passes may be purchased upon arrival for \$18. All trailers must park in approved lot. NO PARKING is allowed in the barn area; this is for active loading and unloading only. KHP reserves the right to tow any vehicle that is not parked in an approved parking space.
2. CAMPING – All those who wish to camp must do so in the Campground, unless prior arrangements are made through KHP management. Please call (888) 4KY-PARK or (888) 459-7272 or reserve online at www.park.ky.gov. Groups of 20 or more, please call (859) 259-4257 or (800) 370-6416. Check out time is noon and strictly enforced; violators will be towed.
3. GOLF CARTS/MOPEDS ETC. – Use of these is a privilege, not a right, extended to show participants. Must be at least 16 years old with a valid driver's license. No ATVs or dirt bikes over 50 cc are allowed on KHP property.
4. DOGS – Must be on a 6' leash at all times or suitably restrained in a tack stall or crate. Loose animals will be removed from the grounds at the owner's expense. DO NOT LEAVE DOGS IN VEHICLES.
5. HORSES AND HORSE DRAWN VEHICLES – Horses and carriages always have right of way.
6. EXHIBITOR ISSUES/SPECIAL REQUEST – All non-emergency problems or special request must be relayed through show management to ensure prompt attention.
7. PACKAGES/DELIVERIES – The Park is not responsible for any deliveries to an event or event participant. Please plan to have packages delivered to your hotel. Any packages delivered to KHP may be returned to sender or assessed a freight handling fee.
8. PARK ADMISISON – Reduced admission is available to event participants and must be obtained at the Visitor's Information Center.
9. ARRIVAL/DEPARTURES – Must comply with contracted ship in / ship out dates.
10. FIRE CODES – As of May 15, 2006, KHP will not allow the following and will be enforced:
 - a. Two wire appliances
 - b. Two wire extension cords
 - c. Light duty indoor extension cords
 - d. Three-way adaptors unless specifically designed for outdoor use
 - e. Any adaptor without 3-wire connections
 - f. Any cut or damaged cords

Online Show Entry - How To Enter A Show

Online Show Entry - Getting Started

What you need:



Proceed to online entry. Go to "My people, horses, shows" page.

- A free account at HorseShowsOnline. If you don't already have an account you can create one when you click the continue button below. HorseShowsOnline basic member is FREE.
- A record in your account for each person and horse that you will use on show entry forms when you enter a show.

How do I get started:

1. Login to HorseShowsOnline by clicking the "Member Services" button in the main menu, OR click the continue button below.
2. Once you are logged in, click the "My Horses, People, Shows" button in the member menu.
3. At the People, Horses, Shows page, add any new people and horses to your account as required on the appropriate tab (IE: My People, My Horses). People and horses are saved with your account. Once you have those records in your account you can use them at every show you enter.
4. Click the "Enter show" button to select the show you want to enter and follow the steps in the online entry wizard.

Steps to enter a show:

- Select the show you want to enter from your "**My People, Horses, Shows**" page on the "**My Show Entries**" tab, or find the show you want to enter in show selector and click the Online Entry icon. This will start the online entry wizard. Make sure you have already created the horses and people in your member account.
- The online entry wizard will guide you through the steps to complete the entry form. The basic steps in the wizard are:
 1. Select the horse, people, and riders for your entry
 2. Select the classes each rider is entered in.
 3. Select the quantity for stalls and other fees.
 4. Confirm your selections
 5. Checkout and submit the show entry.
- The final step generates the completed entry form and submits your entry to the show for review and acceptance. If the show requires a payment at entry time, you will be prompted for your credit card information.

Tips:

- You can cancel the entry part way through the wizard and resume the entry later on. For example if you need to add more people to your account, or you just want to come back and complete the entry later. Unfinished entry forms are listed in your "My entries" tab and will allow you to edit the entry.
- People and horses you create in your account are saved permanently and can be used in other shows you enter. You only need to add people and horses once and then they can be re-used.

ACADEMY ENTRIES CLOSE APRIL 2, 2024

Kentucky State Academy Rules

ATTIRE OF RIDER:

Jodhpurs, vest, tie and long-sleeved shirt, with riding boots and gloves. Hair should be neatly held back so that the back number is visible. Riding suits and hats are prohibited. Protective headgear is required for all riders ages 17 and under.

EQUIPMENT FOR THE HORSES:

Snaffle bridles, double or full bridles with running martingales and German martingales are all permissible, along with appropriate saddle for the division being judged. Any type of leverage bit with a curb chain or strap is not allowed with rein through martingale or a draw rein attached to said bit. Draw reins are only permissible with a snaffle bridle when used in conjunction with a straight, top rein; only one of the two reins are allowed to be through a martingale. Any protective equipment (bell boots, shin boots, knee boots, rundowns, saddle pads etc.) will be permitted. Blunt spurs are optional at the discretion of the instructor. No braiding of the horse; hoof blacking is optional. Training devices such as chains, straps, stretchers and blinkers are NOT allowed in the warm up or the show ring.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

There should be two main divisions: Diagonals to be judged in both divisions.

- **Equitation:** To be judged on basic seat, hands and form, along with effective control of the horse.
- **Horsemanship:** To be judged on showmanship, ring generalship and presentation of the horse to its best ability.

RIDER ELIGIBILITY:

A rider is no longer eligible for the academy division if he/she has shown, dressed in a riding suit in a regular horse show class on any breed/discipline; with the exception of competing in a 4-H Horse Show. This applies to riders that compete in a suit in the walk and trot division- they cannot compete in the walk/trot/canter academy division. Exception to this will be for riders to show in the show rider academy classes. If a show rider is over age 50, has not shown for 10 years or more and has not won a world or national title, he/she is eligible to show in academy classes. A rider who has shown in a driving division only at a regular horse show is eligible to compete in the academy under-saddle division. A rider who has shown in the under-saddle division only at a regular horse show is eligible to complete in the academy driving division.

HORSE ELIGIBILITY:

A horse that is used in an academy competition can be farm or privately owned and must earn its living in a lesson program. It cannot be maintained in training within the current show season.

CROSS ENTERING:

Academy horses (with different riders) are permitted to cross enter in regular classes of a show as long as they meet the academy criteria.

- Management reserves the right to combine and split classes as necessary.

- **It is strongly recommended that class splits be run back-to-back to aid in having less tack and rider changes.**

It is strongly encouraged to not split the show rider classes unless more than 20 entries are present.

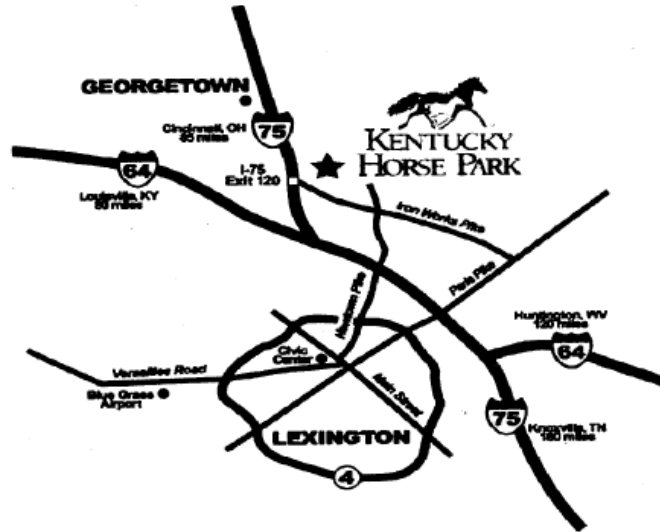
